



# WHAT TO PACK

---

Even though Pilgrim is a large yacht, please bear in mind when packing that space is still limited on board.

Please pack in soft collapsable bags which can be stowed easily. **Hard suitcases cannot be stowed.**

## **Clothes:**

Everything on board is very casual so pack as you would for a beach holiday - swimmers, shorts, hats, casual clothes etc.

Weather is warm during the day but can get chilly at night so bear that, and the mozzies, in mind when packing.

Just in case of any rain (hopefully not!) you may want to bring a spray jacket. We do have several on board, which you can borrow, if you prefer.

## **Toiletries & Medication:**

Please ensure you bring any medication that you are taking.

If you are bringing medication please advise the skipper at time of boarding, in case of an emergency. Please also notify the skipper of any injuries or medical conditions your party has.

Please bring your own toiletries. We have plenty of sunscreen on board but if you have a preferred brand then please bring your own.

Please note: Doctors or chemists will not be accessible after we leave the dock.

## **Snorkel gear:**

We have snorkels and fins (adults & kids), which you can borrow. However if you prefer, feel free to bring your own.

## **Bedlinen & towels:**

All bedlinen & bath towels will be provided.

Please bring your own beach towels.

# WHAT TO PACK

## Gadgets:

- Pilgrim main energy source is 12V (not 240V) so your basic home appliances will not work unless the generator is being run (generally only for one hour a day).
- We do have a USB charging port to charge phone, iPads and cameras at any time, if required.
- The TV can play movies/shows from DVD's, USB or the older iPads (30 pin connector). So if you want to bring something for the kids to watch feel free. (The TV even has 2 sets of headphones connected so not everyone on the boat has to hear it!)
- We have an integrated stereo with volume-controlled speakers throughout. You can plug in iPods, iPhones or androids, so if you want to play some of your own music bring along a compatible device.
- We have a DVD player and the TV can connect to your iPad (only older models) so you can bring some DVD's or download some shows for kids.

## Internet:

- As we will be sailing in remote areas we recommend that you assume there will be no internet reception. In some places there will not be phone reception either so take the opportunity to switch off from city life!

Please note: In case of emergency we have a VHF radio where we can communicate with nearby vessels or coastal stations.

### In summary what to pack:

Clothes, swimmers, hat, beach towel, medication & toiletries, camera all in a SOFT COLLAPSIBLE BAG

### Optional to pack (you can borrow ours):

Your own snorkel & fins, sunscreen, spray jacket, iPod or music device, DVD's or movies for the kids (or you!).

### What not to pack:

Bedlinen, bath towels & no hard suitcases, suits & ties!!
